Welcome to the sixth beer & cider festival at The Brewery Tap, and the first of this year's four planned festivals.

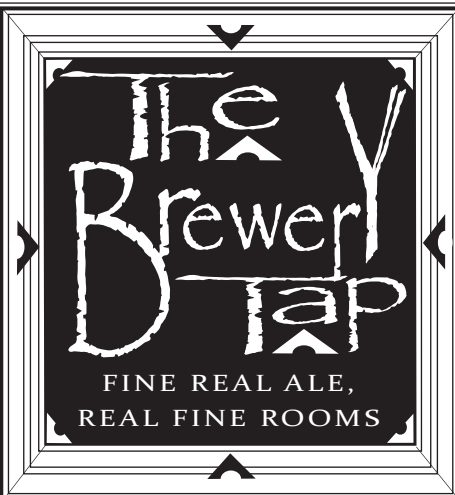
'Abingdon's first beer festival' was actually held in the car park of The Brewery Tap back in October 2004, which will once again provide the setting for this spring festival.
