Loose Cannon - Abingdon Bridge

Mid Brown in colour with a well rounded bitterness, Full flavoured with a floral aftertaste.

Brown - 4.1% - £3.35 0.5 Miles



Hook Norton - Hooky Bitter

A subtly balanced, golden bitter, hoppy to the nose, malty on the palate - the classic session beer, eminently drinkable.

Golden - 3.6% - £3.40 24.3 Miles



Batemans - All Seasons

This springtime-seeded, summer-cropped, autumn-malted and winter-hopped ale is a new addition to this brewery's full-time range of beers. It's copper-red in colour and brewed with pale and crystal malts, rye, wheat malt and oats, combining with the hops used to impart all that is best from all of the seasons.

Copper - 4.2% - £3.45 118 Miles



Hook Norton - Hooky Gold

A very pale, crisp beer, confidently displaying its hop character. The first Hook Norton beer to feature American hops. A fruity aroma and a pleasant, light taste.

Pale - 4.1% - £3.45 24.3 Miles



Moorhouse's - Blond Witch

A pale coloured ale with a crisp delicate fruit flavour, dry and refreshing with a smooth hop finish.

Blonde - 4.5% - £3.65 151.9 Miles



Hook Norton - Old Hooky

A beautifully balanced beer, fruity by nature, with a well-rounded body and the suggestive echo of Crystal Malt.

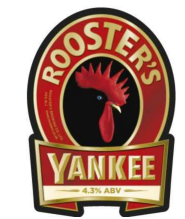
Malty - 4.6% - £3.55 24.3 Miles
